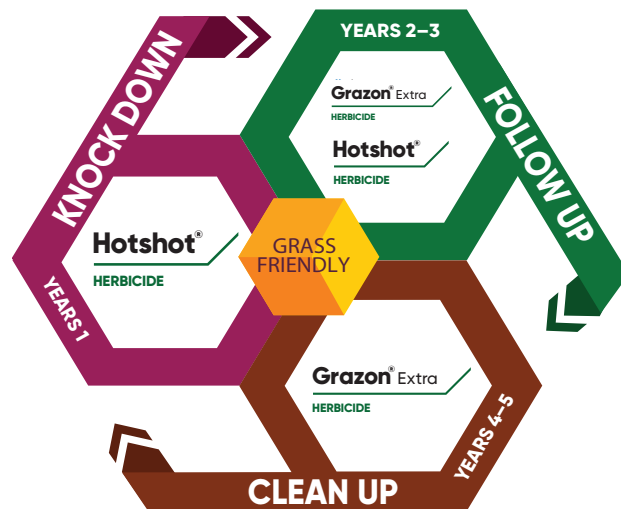


## Three Cycle Plan

## Knock down large areas of fireweed with Hotshot® Herbicide

Fireweed is considered one of the worst weeds of coastal pastures throughout south eastern Australia and is included in the list of Australia's Weeds of National Significance (WoNS).

The best approach to fireweed control is to prevent it establishing by ensuring that there is a dense cover of pasture in autumn and winter. If, however, fireweed has already taken hold, Hotshot gives very good control of fireweed and associated weeds such as thistles.

Registered for boom application at 1.5 L/ha, Hotshot contains aminopyralid and fluroxypyr. It should be used in predominantly grass-based pastures. Both kikuyu and couch grass may see transitory yellowing from Hotshot.

## Follow up with Hotshot

Follow up your Hotshot broadcast treatment with a high volume spot spraying with Grazon® Extra Herbicide or Hotshot depending on the other weeds present.

When small infestations of fireweed are identified, act immediately to prevent the situation from becoming worse and to increase the likelihood of containment, by spot spraying.

Using Grazon Extra or Hotshot will also give you control of other weeds found in conjunction with the regrowth such as thistles, with no damage to grasses.

## Clean up with Grazon Extra

Now that your fireweed is largely under control, continue to spot spray with Grazon Extra or Hotshot.

Early detection and removal is vital. Seed is long-lived in the soil and is produced in large quantities, so prevention of seeding is important. Continued vigilance on your property for new outbreaks is required to prevent the establishment of the weed.

**Grazon Extra may cost more but you will control more weeds, spend less time following up, wear out less machinery, hand over less in wages and find controlling weeds less of a pain.**
